Sub: Strengthening of HMIS for Anemia Mukht Bharat Indicators.

Anemia has been a serious public health issue in our country since many years. One in two under five children, adolescent girls and women including pregnant women and lactating mothers are anemic. Taking cognizance of this, Government of India developed “**Anemia Mukht Bharat’ (AMB)** strategy in adherence to the **POSHAN Abhiyan** with the target beneficiaries through the life cycle approach.

One of the important aspect of the program is to conduct strong monitoring and supervision of the program, for which following HMIS indicators need to be monitored regularly:

The HMIS indicators for the program are as follows:

Age Group	HMIS Indicator
Children 6-59 months	9.9: Percentage of children 6-59 months provided 8 10 doses (1ml) of iron and folic acid (IFA) syrup (Bi weekly)
Children 5-9 Years	23.1+23.3: Percentage of children covered under WIFS JUNIOR (5-9 years) provided 4-5 iron and folic acid (IFA) tablets In schools + out of school)
Adolescents 10-19 years	22.1.1: Percentage of girls (6-12 class) provided 4 IFA tablets in schools 22.1.1.a: Percentage of girls (6-12 class) provided 4 IFA tablets in schools 22.1.1.b: Percentage of boys (6-12 class) provided 4 IFA tablets in

	schools
Pregnant women	1.2.4: Percentage of pregnant women (PW) given 180 iron and folic acid (IFA) tablets
Stocks	19.6 Percentage of stocks available for iron and folic acid (IFA) tablets - Red (Adult) 19.7 Percentage of stocks available for iron and folic acid (IFA) tablets – Blue (Adolescent 10–19 years) 19.8 Percentage of stocks available for iron and folic acid (IFA) tablets - Pink (Junior 6–10 years) 19.9 Percentage of stocks available for iron HMIS and folic acid (IFA) - Syrup
