Sub: Reporting of consumption of IFA tablets under Weekly Iron Folic Acid Supplementation (WIFS) programme in Health Management Information System (HMIS)

Ref: M.D. NHM letter no.5596/419/08 Dt. 17.05.17

Madam / Sir

Nutritional anemia is a public health problem in our state, primarily caused due to iron deficiency. To address this the WIFS programme aims to provide IFA supplementations to the children aged 6 years to 19 years. Under the WIFS programme, school children aged 6 to 10 years are provided with IFA pink tablet & 10 to 19 years of children are provided with IFA blue tablets by the teachers and 10 to 19 years of out-of-school adolescent girls are provided with IFA blue tablet by the AWW.

The consumption report of the IFA pink and blue tablets are reported in the HMIS of H&FW department after the reports are received from the S&ME dept. and WCD&MS dept. from the block and district level. Since the Government of India (GoI) utilises the Anemia Mukh Bharat dashboard, developed under the Anemia Mukh Bharat strategy for assessing performance of the states and districts, in-time entry of the monthly consumption data of IFA in HMIS is crucial.

Keeping the above things in view and aligning the reporting with HMIS of our state, you are requested to kindly instruct the block level officials (BEO, S&ME dept. & CDPO, WCD&MS dept.) to provide monthly consumption report to the block MOI/C, H&FW dept. by 3rd day of following month with a copy mark to the district level officials (DEO, S&ME dept and DSWO, WCD&MS dept. respectively). The district level officials (DEO, S&ME dept. & DSWO, WCD&MS dept.) may further be instructed to provide the complied monthly consumption report of IFA to the CDM&PHO, H&FW Dept. by 10th day of the following month. This will help in compiling and incorporating in-time monthly consumption data in HMIS by the district level officials of H&FW dept by as per the timeline mentioned in the reference letter (page-5).

Hence, you are requested to kindly look into the matter and initiate appropriate steps for strengthening of monthly HMIS reporting of IFA consumption of our state.
