

## MINUTES OF STATE COORDINATION COMMITTEE MEETING FOR NATIONAL DEWORMING DAY- AUGUST 2020 ROUND

**Date: 17<sup>th</sup> June 2020**

**Venue: Conference Hall of National Health Mission, Bhubaneswar, Odisha.**

The State Coordination Committee Meeting for National Deworming Day (NDD) August 2020 round was held in the Conference hall of National Health Mission, Bhubaneswar, Odisha on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2020 under the Chairpersonship of Mr. P.K. Mohapatra, Addl. Chief Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department, Govt. of Odisha. The members present in the meeting are enlisted in Annexure-I.

The Mission Director, NHM, Odisha welcomed all and gave a brief introduction regarding the objective of the meeting which was followed by a presentation made by Director, Family Welfare, Govt. of Odisha. It was followed by discussion and deliberation regarding the planning for implementation of National Deworming Day and Vitamin A supplementation programme, both scheduled to be held in the month of August 2020 and the following decisions taken.

Due to the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic the orientation programmes shall be carried out using digital platform, supported by UNICEF.</li> <li>- UNICEF to provide a detailed plan for the online orientation programme which can be carried out in the month of August 2020, involving the participants from H&amp;FW, S&amp;ME and W&amp;CD Dept.</li> <li>- Under the FMR code 3.1.1.1.6 there is a provision of ASHA incentive @Rs100/ ASHA/ round under NDD programme. However, in the NHM PIP FY 20-21 no funds have been provisioned under the above-mentioned budget head and the same was communicated to M.D., NHM vide DFW letter no.593. Dt.4.6.2020.
