# Roles & Responsibilities of ASHA for Paediatric COVID Care



## Awareness Generation in Community

- » What are the signs and symptoms of COVID -19 in the Paediatric age group
- » What are the red flag signs
- » Whom to contact in an emergency
- » Where to go in case of symptoms
- » What are the COVID Appropriate Behavior (CAB)
- » When and where to get tested
- » Reassurance to the community that there is no need for panic

### Whom to visit?

- Visit all houses with children & adolescent and communities

### How often?

- During routine services and house to house visit



## Surveillance

- House to House survey

### Whom to visit?

All homes with special focus on:

- Influenza like illness in the child (fever/cold/ runny nose/sore throat/cough etc.)



- Acute respiratory symptoms in the child
- When the child has co-morbid conditions (chronic disease/malnutrition)



## Case Management and follow-up for Paediatric COVID

- Adherence to home isolation guidelines
- Post-COVID follow-up
- Linking of the child to the higher facility in case of complication

### Whom to visit?

- COVID positive/suspected children

### How often?

- At least once a day/telephone enquiry



## Vaccinations

- Dispel myths and misconception
- Mobilization for Routine Immunization of the child
- Facilitation in registration of eligible parents and caregivers for COVID vaccination
